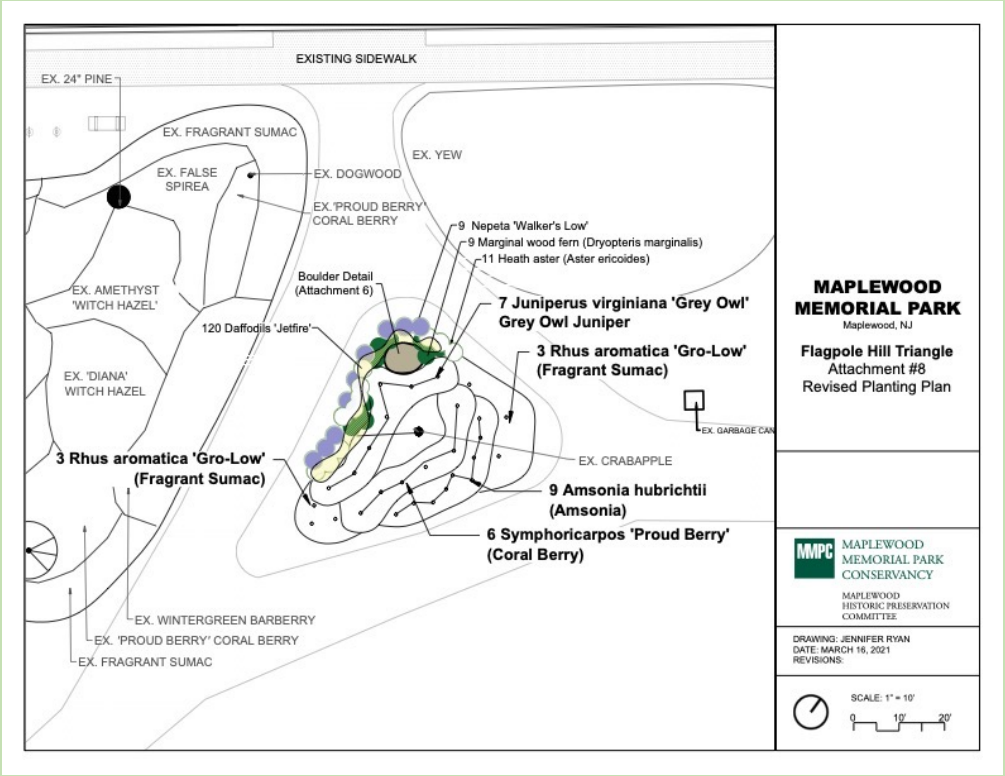




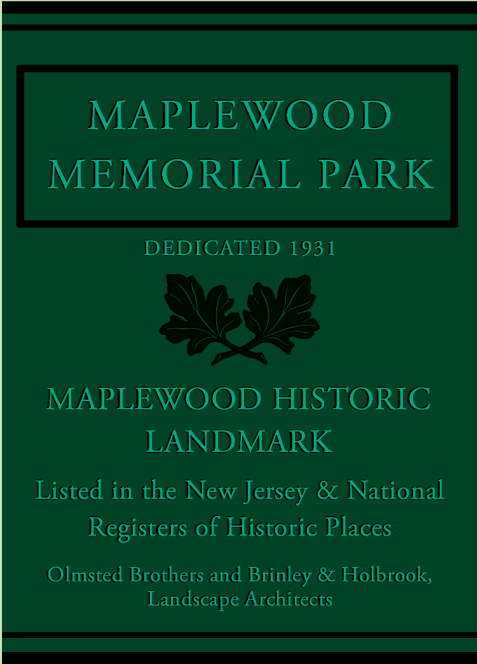

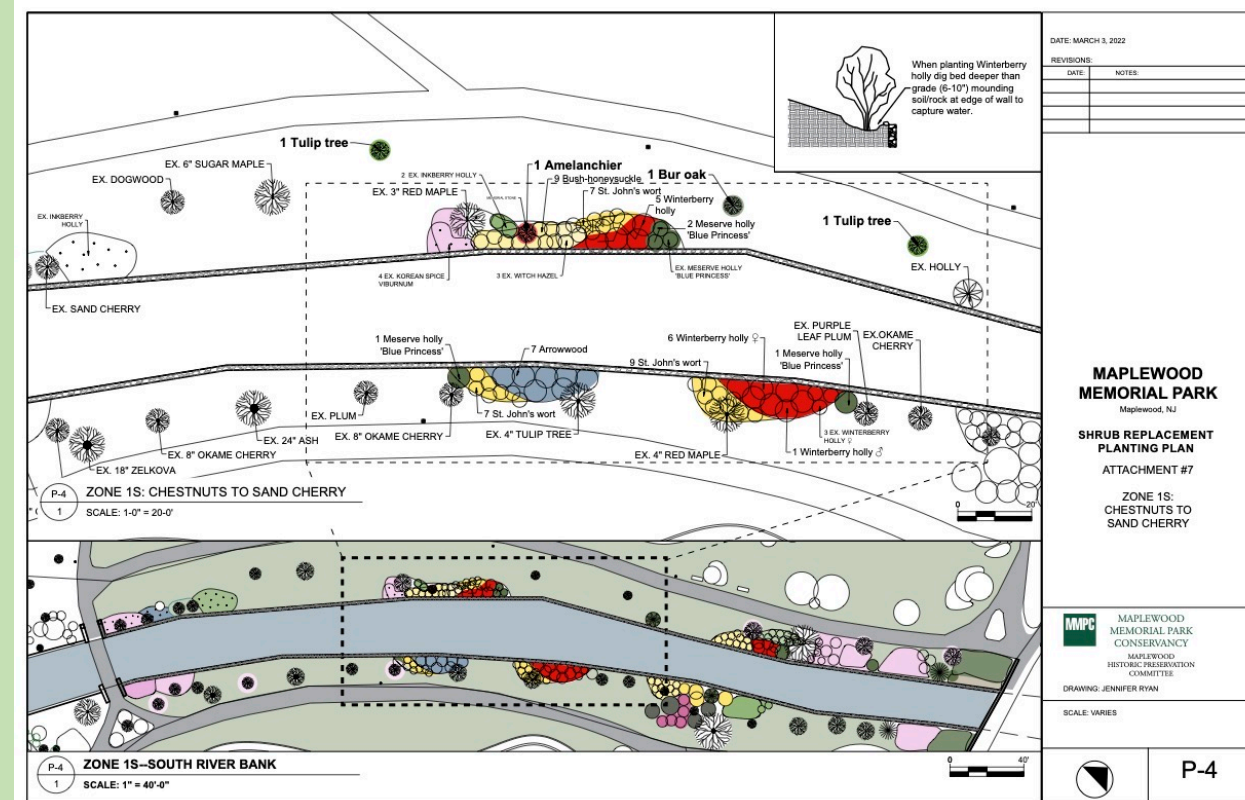
Plans to restore and enhance border and riverbank plantings in 11 sections throughout the park from 2022 to 2024





# Project Timeline

- ✓ Presented to Township Planning & Engineering
  - ✓ Funding secured from Open Space Trust Fund
- ✓ Approved by Maplewood Historic Preservation Commission
  - ✓ Approved by State Historic Preservation Office
- ✓ Timeline established for executing multiple phases for project
  - ✓ Project begun in 2022
  - ✓ Spring 2023 plantings will continue along the riverbanks

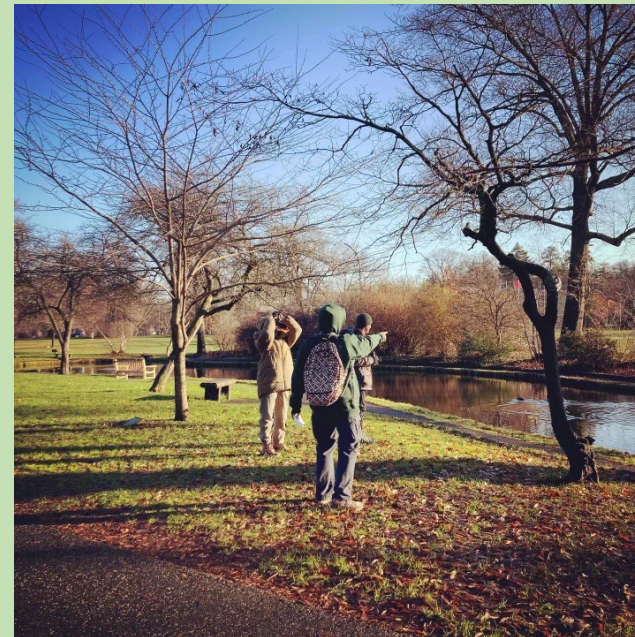

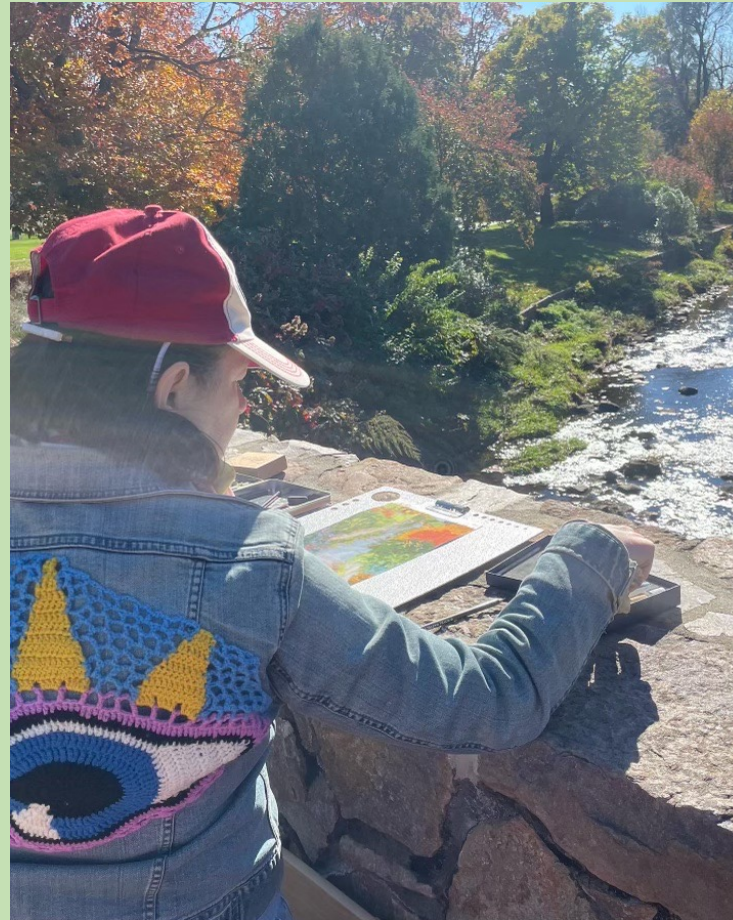
